David McCarthy presented his talk, **The 2013 Saddle Ridge Gold Coin Hoard.**

"We all dream about discovering buried treasure; seeing the real thing in person – piles of gold coins encrusted in dirt and rust – the experience was just indescribable," said McCarthy. "Never in my wildest dreams would I imagine coins coming out of the ground in the kind of condition that I saw in front of me. Many pieces were finer than anything known in major collections or museums." David went on to catalog and picture many of the rarities found in the hoard.

PCNS member and newly elected ANA governor, Don Kagin, presented David with a certificate from the ANA for his numismatic education efforts. Don then presented President Herb Miles with an ANA certificate honoring the PCNS on its 100th Anniversary.
